## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed for students who have successfully completed Algebra I and Geometry. It will prepare students for higher mathematics through an in-depth study of number systems, algebraic operations, relations and functions, and data analysis and statistics. This course is EOI tested.

MATERIALS REQUIRED DAILY A textbook will be checked out to each student. Please have the following supplies by Monday of the first full week of school:

1) Notebook (3-ring binder is suggested)
2) Pencil
3) Pen (NOT blue or black - grading purposes)
4) Loose-leaf paper
5) Graph paper
6) Kleenex and/or hand sanitizer

## COURSE WORK

1) Daily work: Daily work will be picked up for correctness, completion, or random assignment numbers. Homework quizzes may also be given.
2) Quizzes: Quizzes will be given often, usually after every couple sections in the book. The quizzes may be exact homework problems or ones similar to them. Quiz corrections can be completed during RAO, or before/after school. Common assessments can be taken multiple times to master the concepts. It is your responsibility to retake these quizzes.
3) Tests: There will be at least one test per unit.

9 weeks cumulative exam - At the end of the nine weeks grading period there will be a cumulative exam given. This exam score will count as a 100 point test.
Both quizzes and tests should be kept and corrected to help aid in semester exam reviews.
4) Final Exam: You may be able to waive your $2^{\text {nd }}$ semester final depending on your EOI score and the work you do after the EOI. The EOI is NOT the end of the class. If you choose not to complete assignments after the EOI, the privilege of waiving can and will be taken away.
5) Notebook: Students are required to take daily notes and keep all work throughout the class.
